<u>March 7th-</u>Fine Arts Fest arrive 1:15p for a 2pm performance at Grove.

<u>March 14</u>th- IGSMA contest will be at Indian Trails School in Addison at 9:10a. Students should report to school at 7:45am and will go together on a bus. The students will play for a panel of 3 judges and will be given feedback. Information will be going home on Feb.11th. Parents can go to watch the final concert and can opt to pick their kids up instead of taking the bus back to school. If the students make Division one, they may qualify for a state contest in April.

<u>April 8th</u> -Solo/ensemble, \$4 plus per event plus the pianist fee paid for by the students. District pays for the judges We will need to pay for food for the directors and judges. This payment is split between all schools.

An audition would be submitted. The students would be bused to Holmes and there would be a rehearsal with a guest conductor and a dinner. The students would be responsible for learning their music outside of school. Funding is still being figured out and will be discussed at the institute days. District might cover the cost of the clinicians and busing. Mrs. Berger suggested that we could have the students pay for the pizza or possibly the boosters could provide some of the funding.
